TREASURER'S REPORT: Presented by Donna Goldsby. For the month of September, the church received \$61,478.65 in contributions, paid out \$70,715.63 in expenses for a shortage of \$9,236.98. Our YTD contributions are \$561,872.60, paid out \$617,980.82 for a shortage of \$56,108.22.

NEW BUSINESS: A. Election of Messengers to Pensacola Bay Baptist Association Annual Meeting. The meeting will be held November 13, 2022 at 4:30—5:30 at Olive Baptist Church.

B. Question/Answer concerning proposed 2023 Church budget. Presented by Chuck Keistler. Handouts included: The Proposed Budget for 2023, Budget Analysis as of 08-31-2022 (circular and bar graph). Over all projected shortage for 2023 \$63,763.90. Voting for the Proposed Budget will occur at the next Business Meeting November 16, 2022.

Q—Is the Insurance Expense for \$110,000.00 necessary? **A**—Coverage is for \$12M. Our Insurance Committee chairperson (John Bonelli) explained the committee is looking at other possibilities to cut costs i.e. increasing the deductible, change the annual renewal date, eliminating coverage on Butler Chapel, Clothing Room House and other out buildings. These cuts could save approximately \$19,000.00. It should be noted that we had three (3) large expenses in September (Audio Visual \$5,790.24, quarterly General Literature expense of \$2,224.28 and a Utility bill of \$14,168.40. Also note we have \$20,522.97 in Capital Escrow/Building Fund and \$45,000.00 in the Emergency Fund.
